Remember our BookStore/Lending Library/Church Library

Just a reminder about Midway's bookstore/lending library across from the church library. We still have dozens of wonderful children's books, brand new, for sale at "Bargain Basement" prices. Our hardcover books, whose content ranges are suitable for toddlers through tweens, are only \$2 each or 3 for \$5.00. Softcover books and toddler board books are only \$1 each. The books will be sold at our bazaar in November, and once they're gone, they're gone. So don't miss out on great books at such amazing prices. Browse through the children's selections anytime, take what you want and put your cash or check in the offertory, noting "Books" so the payment is credited to our charitable account, which is used to purchase toiletries and school supplies for local youngsters in need.

The Lending Library with adult fiction, biographies, devotionals and cookbooks are available for borrowing OR purchasing. Many of the current novels, mysteries, etc. have been read once and are in Like New condition, so they're even suitable to be given as gifts. If you prefer to read and return, just take the book you want and return it at your leisure. If you want to purchase the book, a recommended price is \$1.50 for books in Like New condition, or \$1 if the condition is a bit less than that. There are also CDs and DVDs available for purchase or borrowing, as well as some "Oldies but Goodies" VHS tapes for anyone who has held onto their VCR. A price list is posted in the bookstore.

Our church library has many interesting religious themed books and devotionals, as well as the Presbyterian Book of Order and Book of Confessions that can be borrowed, but not purchased. Cindy Wentzky painstakingly set up a Library Management System several years ago, which you'll find in the church library. We encourage our members and friends to browse through the church library and bookstores, and take advantage of the reading opportunities that exist there. We're also happy to accept donations of books, CDs and DVDs that are in great condition and appropriate reading/viewing materials for our church members and their families.
