Our Vision Committee has been meeting on a regular basis since early February. The Committee members are: LeNelle Chastain, Donetta Dodwell, Goetz Eaton, Linda Mylod, Jacky Stamps, Keith Wentzky, and myself, as well as Debbie Foster and Pressley Cox from Foothills Presbytery, and Paul Grier and Olanda Carr from the Presbyterian Foundation.

We have been using Joan Gray's book, *Sailboat Church: Helping Your Church Rethink Its Mission and Practice*, which emphasizes the importance of relying on the Holy Spirit. Also, we have reflected regularly on Luke 10:1-12, which speaks of "The Mission of the Seventy."

While we will pause for the summer, the Session and its committees will be addressing matters that have come from the Vision Committee. For example, we have identified the need to update the church's cemetery policy in our Manual of Operations. The Administration and Finance Committee is working with the cemetery subcommittee on this matter.

The Vision Committee has suggested that consideration be given to the annexation of our property by the City of Anderson. And the Session is actively exploring the possibility.

The Vision Committee has recognized the need for an enhanced outreach to people in the Midway Community. The Community Life and Mission Committee will be exploring ways to connect with people moving into the new homes near us. And a subcommittee will be looking into developing a social media presence. We would like to let people know about events such as an upcoming class on Advanced Directives utilizing the Five Wishes plan, a class on Dealing with Grief, our Meals on Wheels program, and fun things like Bingo.

These are just a few of the ideas that have come from our Vision Committee meetings. If you have any suggestions, just let me or one of our committee members know. Please pray for the Committee and the endeavors that come from it. And pray as Jesus instructed in Luke 10:2:
